Praises!!!

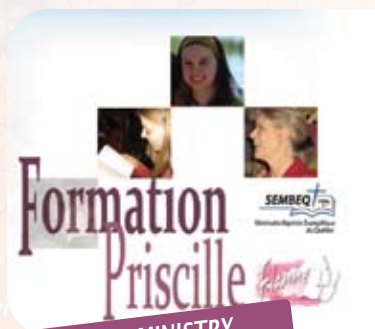
